

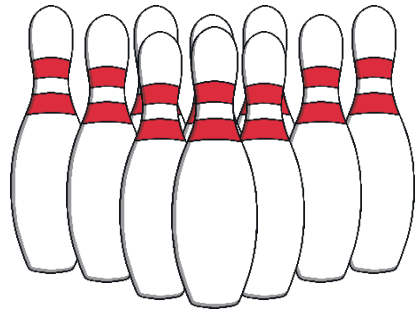

4. It was everything I had imagined a French dinner party would be — **multiple** courses, a variety of cheeses and bottles of champagne.

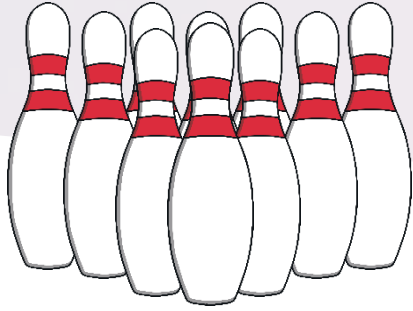
