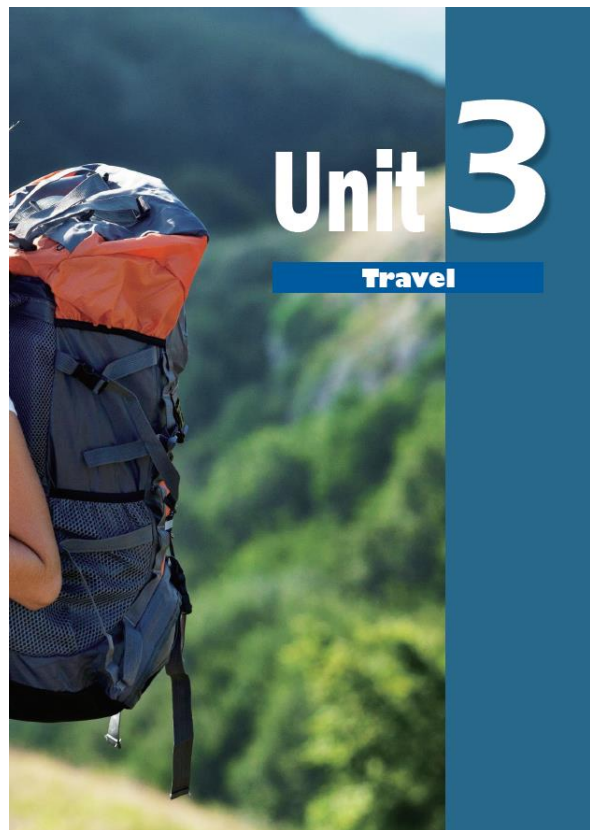

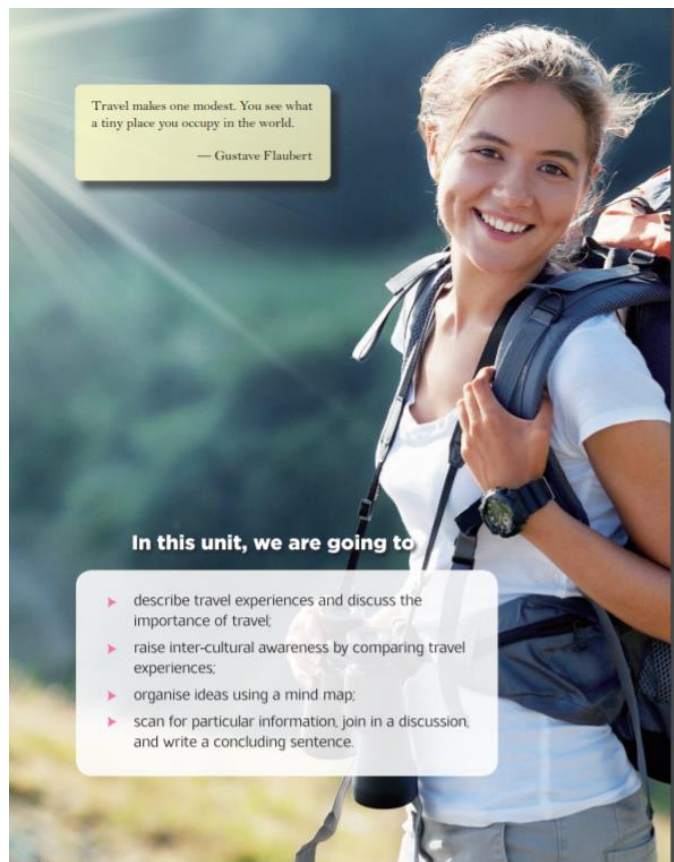

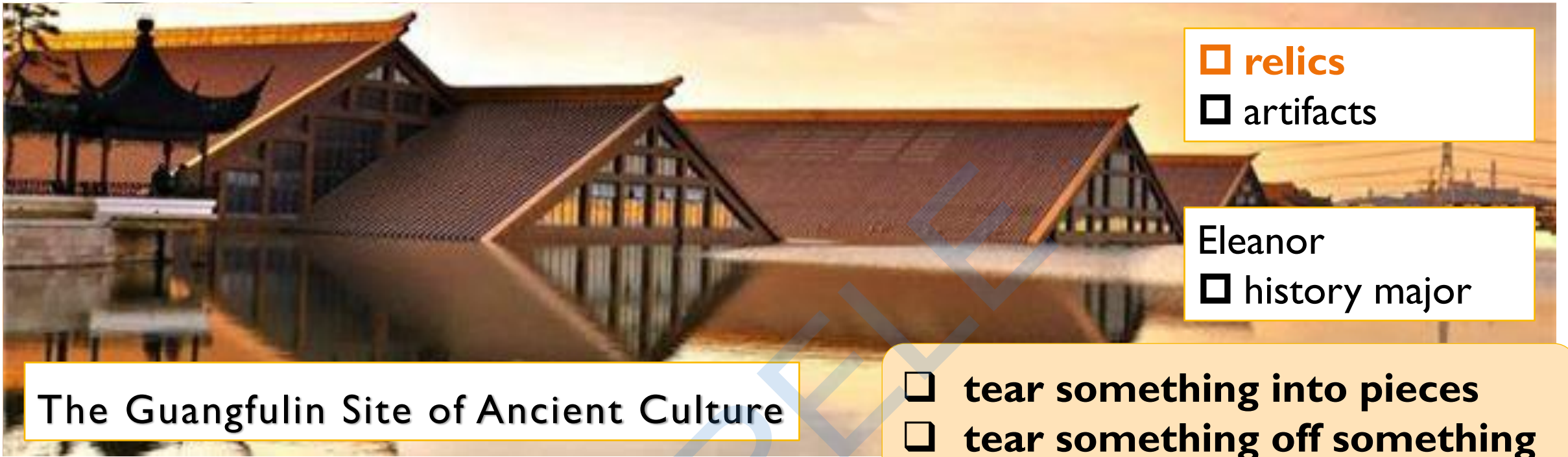

Sample Essay

In addition, since it is Eleanor's first visit to Shanghai, the Oriental Pearl Tower **gives her an opportunity to see** the fascinating night view of the city. I am sure she won't be able to **tear her eyes away from** the city **decorated with** colorful lights.
- As for the accommodation, since it is Eleanor's first visit to Shanghai, she will be interested in learning more about this city. Thus, she'd better stay in a guesthouse since the hosts can introduce her to the local culture and customs.
