# “Polysemy”

**serious** ['sɪəriəs] adj.

1. severe in effect; bad 严重的, 糟糕的 e.g., *There were no reports of serious injuries.*

2. not joking or intended to be funny 严肃的, 认真的

e.g., *Please don't laugh — I'm being serious.*

3. determined to follow a particular plan or action 坚决的, 认真的

e.g., *Is she serious about going to live abroad?*

**Polysemy** refers to one word having two or more distinct but related meanings. We sometimes have to use **context clues** to understand its meaning in use.



# Context Clues

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
... when I was finally ready to get serious, you left me off the varsity. You told me I wasn't good enough. I was **crushed**.
