• Title	"People's Artist" (1953)



From carpenter to great artist — this was the course of Qi Baishi's life. He achieved success by coupling talent with hard work. In 1953, he was **①honoured** with the title **"People's Artist"** by the Chinese government.

(Para 1)

① honour

- vt. to give public praise, an award or a title to sb for sth they have done 给予表扬(或奖励、头衔、称号)
- honour sb. with sth. (for sth.)
- = sb. is honoured with sth. (by sb. for sth.)
- e.g. Qi was honoured with the title by the Chinese government for his great achievements in art.

- vt. join together; combine two parts 连接,结合 couple A with B
- = combine A with B

e.g.

He achieved success by **coupling** talent **with** hard work.

- = He achieved success by <u>combining</u> talent <u>with</u> hard work.
- = He achieved success because he was <u>talented</u> and <u>hardworking</u>.

honour sb. with sth. ; couple A with B

- Qi devoted all his life to preserving world peace and reminded people to play their part.
- Qi's works <u>remind us that</u> it's our common wish to create a harmonious and prosperous society.

Qi's masterpiece — "Shrimps"

By coupling talent with hard work, Qi created so many amazing works. Undoubtedly, the paintings of shrimps are (1) <u>recognised</u> as his masterpieces.

Shrimps are the common (2) <u>subjects</u> in Qi's paintings, (3) <u>symbolic</u> of his happiness in childhood. Instead of following ancient models, Qi developed a (4) <u>personal</u> style. Qi's paintings of shrimps, rich in (5) <u>expression</u> and detail, are created in a fresh and (6) <u>lively</u> manner, using shades of black ink to show a shrimp's body and give it a (7) <u>real-life</u> feel.
