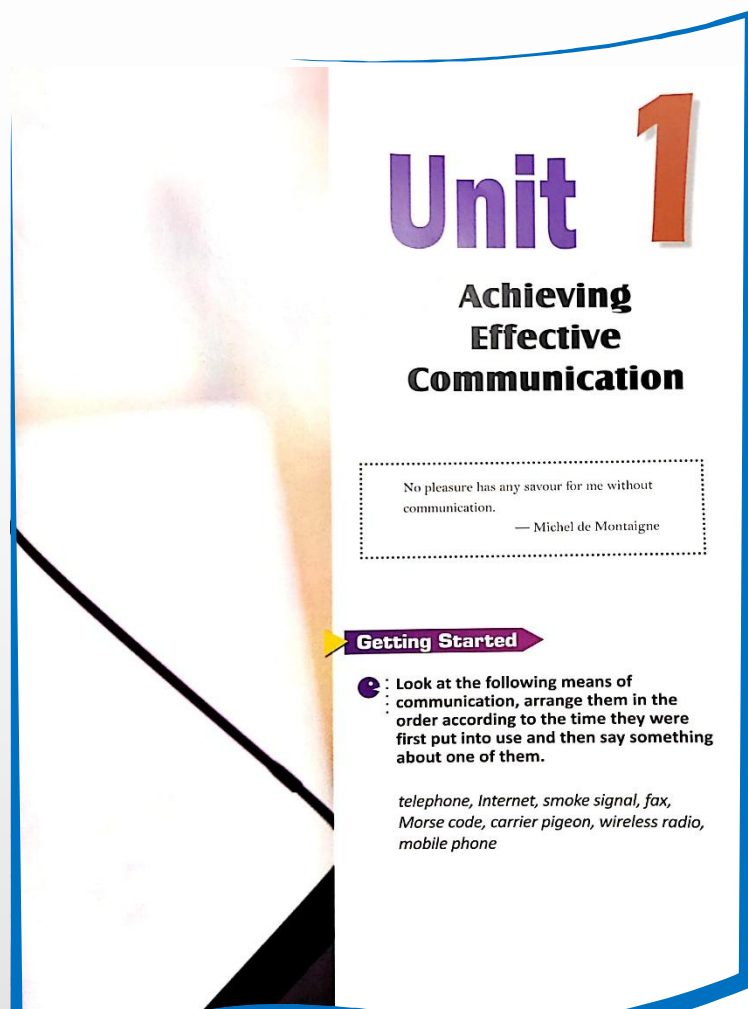




# Rewrite I
