

Writing Strategy: Grasping main points

To write a summary, you need to identify the main points in different textual patterns. The main points of a text vary according to its textual pattern: for a generalspecific text, the main points involve a general statement and specific details; for a problem-solution text, the main points include problems and solutions; for a claimcounterclaim text, the main points involve a claim, a counterclaim and evidence.

Guided Writing

General statement: A few things you should bear in mind while you're improving your skills to keep the audience engaged while delivering a speech.

Detail 1: Speak with passion.

Detail 2: Move around on stage when you change topics or approach the audience

when you make a point or pose a question.


Detail 3: Add some personality to your presentation.

Detail 4: Be a presenter, not a salesman.
