

  - 1. China has helped promote employment in Latin America and the Caribbean.

Supporting statistics: China created 1.8 million jobs for Latin America and the Caribbean region from 1990 to 2016.

2. Many Chinese people now live a wealthier life than before.

Supporting statistics: According to current UN (United Nations) standards, more than 700 million Chinese people have been lifted out of poverty, accounting for more than 70 percent of the global total over the same period.

3. China is a major trade partner of the disadvantaged countries.

Supporting statistics: Since 2009, China has been the largest export market for the LDCs (Least Developed Countries), and absorbed 20 percent of their exports.

4. Tourism in many countries benefits much from Chinese tourists.

Supporting statistics: In 2017, outbound tourist trips made by Chinese citizens exceeded 130 million person-times, generating \$115.29 billion of overseas tourism spending.


