

Example	Type of adverbial clause	Meaning
1. Eleanor had a good time when she was visiting Rome.	time	to give a reason
2. The ceiling was so breathtaking that Eleanor couldn't tear her eyes away from it.	result	to express an aim or goal of an act
3. Although there is a large offering of food for tourists in Rome, not all of it is very good in quality.	concession	to indicate the result(s) of an act or event
4. She felt lucky because she also visited Amsterdam in the summer.	reason	to express a condition, real or imagined
5. You ought to pack a first-aid kit so that medical treatment can be given in an emergency.	purpose	to show when something happens
6. You must have a driver's license if you want to drive a car or travel around America.	condition	to show contrast between two statements


# Brainstorm conjunctions

Type of adverbial clauses	Example	Conjunction
time	She has stayed in the hotel <u>since</u> she arrived in Rome.	since
condition	We will not postpone the sports meeting <u>unless</u> it rains.	unless
result	The book was <u>so</u> interesting <u>that</u> I couldn't tear my eyes away from it.	so...that
reason	<u>Since</u> she is a tourist, she would like to have a guide.	since
concession	He is used to the package tour <u>even though</u> he dislikes the tight schedule.	even though
purpose	She has downloaded a travel planning app <u>so that</u> she can make an agenda for the summer vacation.	so that

condition	We will not postpone the sports meeting <u>unless</u> it rains.	<b>unless</b> , If, as long as
result	The book was <u>so</u> interesting <u>that</u> I couldn't tear my eyes away from it.	<b>so...that</b> , such...that
reason	<u>Since</u> she is a tourist, she would like to have a guide.	<b>since</b> , because, as, now that
concession	He is used to the package tour <u>even though</u> he dislikes the tight schedule.	<b>even though</b> , although, though
purpose	She has downloaded a travel planning app <u>so that</u> she can make an agenda for the summer vacation.	<b>so that</b> , in order that
