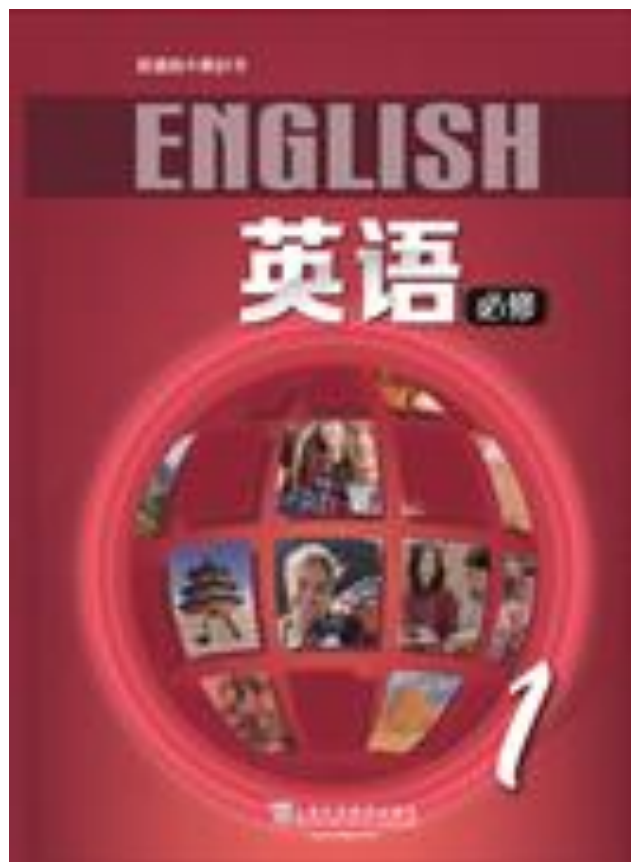

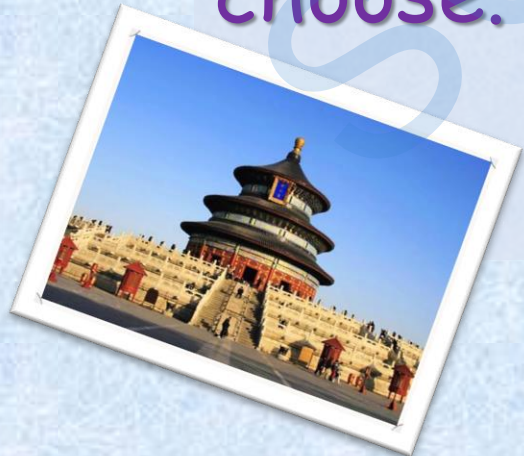

♦ Interrupting someone who has interrupted you

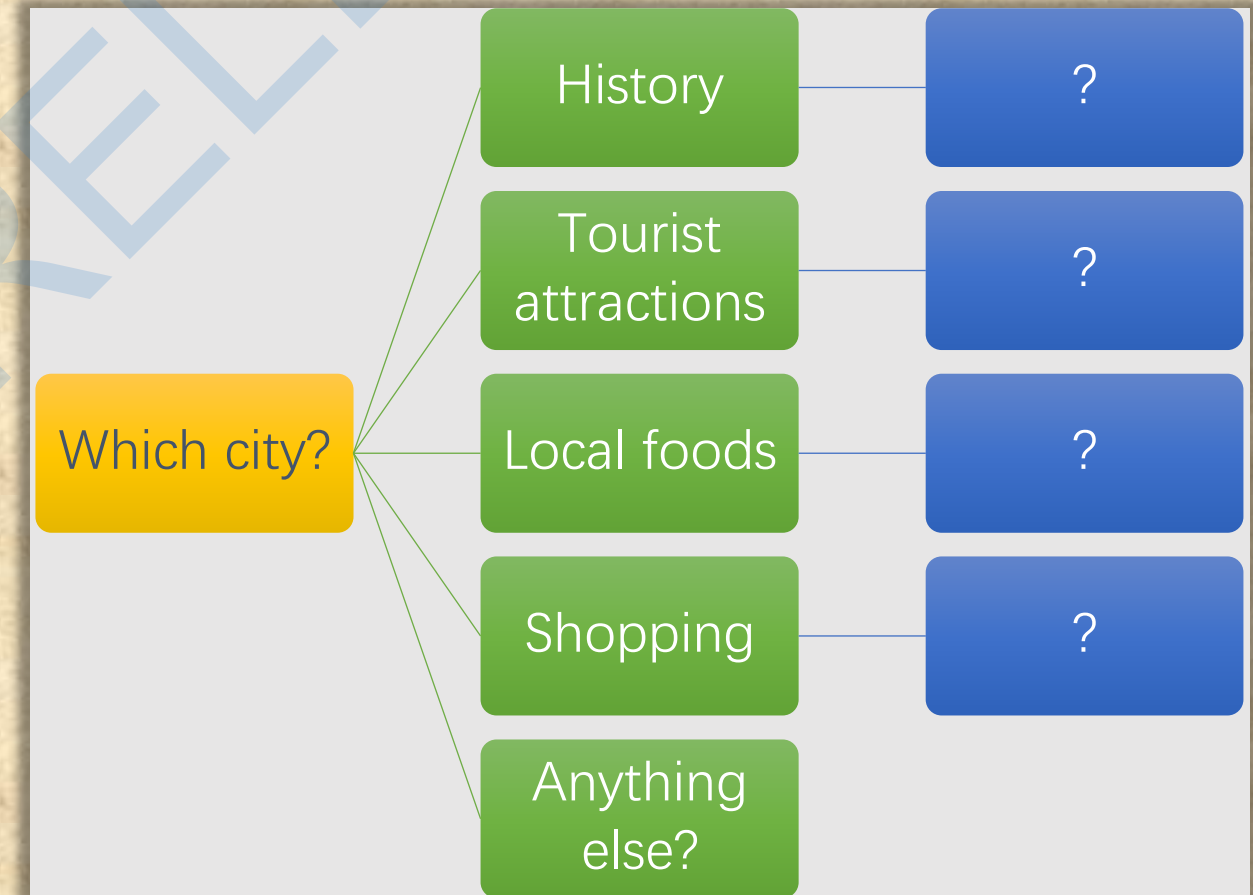
- B. Can I continue, please?

♦ Continuing after an interruption

- A. As I was saying, I think/feel...
- C. Continuing where I left off...
- F. I'd like to return to my argument.
- J. To get back to what I was saying, I think/feel...

Functions of concluding sentences

Restatement

- Paraphrasing what has been stated in the topic sentence

Summary

- Summarizing all the major points previously discussed

Recommendation

- Introducing his or her suggestions or recommendations based on the arguments that have been presented

Prediction

- Making a prediction about the future
