



Is that an interview?

Q1: What is your concept of true friendship? ↓

A: True friendship is having faith in someone, respecting the person from the bottom of our heart, and helping the person whenever he or she is in need. ↓

How to conduct an interview?

A: How do you usually spend time with your friends?

B: Sometimes we meet, talk and play together. I like to listen to my friends, but I don't like to give them advice because I don't want to change them.

A: Let me put it in another way: you don't like to give them suggestions but listen to them while talking and playing together.

B: Exactly. I prefer listening to giving ideas.

A: Do you mean that you are a good listener, and not bossy or controlling?

B: I think so.

How to conduct an interview?

Q1: What is your concept of true friendship? ↓

A: True friendship is having faith in someone, respecting the person from the bottom of our heart, and helping the person whenever he or she is in need. ↓

Q2: Did you usually have a lot of good friends or few close friends? ↓

A: Actually, I don't have many friends. Only a few who are selfish and mix with me only when they need something from me. I'm in search of a good friend...and I think it'll never end. (sigh) ↓

Q3: Did you fight often with your close friends? ↓

A: No. I don't fight with the few number of friends I have. ↓

Q4: Can you go out of your way to help your friends? ←

A: There is a saying "A friend in need is a friend indeed", so if we want good friends, then we also should be good to them and help them whenever they are in need. Otherwise, if we ourselves fall into trouble, then who will help our friends? ↓

gratitude

How to conduct an interview?

Checklist

- Does my interview include a beginning to brief introduce myself and the interview purpose?
- Does my interview include an ending to show my gratitude to my interviewee?
- Do I check the interviewee's answer through the paraphrasing strategy of:
 - changing the order of the ideas/ words
 - changing the word/ grammatical form
 - using synonyms for some words/ expressions?

How to conduct an interview?

A: *Hello, may I have an interview with you on friendship?*

B: *Sure.*

A: *Thank you very much. My name is Emma. Nice to meet you!*

B: *I am Jason. Nice to meet you too.*

A: *May I ask if you were another person, would you like to make friends with yourself? Why?*

B: *Of course, YES! I am a very easy-going person, always ready to lend a helping hand to people around. You can always count on me when you meet with difficulties.*

A: *In other words, you always help people and have a nice temper.*

B: *Right. I am a reliable friend.*

A: *Thank you for taking this interview. It's nice to chat with you.*

B: *My pleasure.*

What's their view on friendship?

In my interviewee's opinion, he is a good friend to make, because his character is easy-going, reliable and he always helps people around him no matter what difficulties they encounter.
