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

Over 50 sites in China are on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Among them are the Mausoleum of Emperor Qin Shi Huang (inscribed in 1987), Mogao Caves (1987), Peking Man Site at Zhoukoudian (1987), South China Karst (2007), China Danxia (2010) and Hubei Shennongjia (2016).
