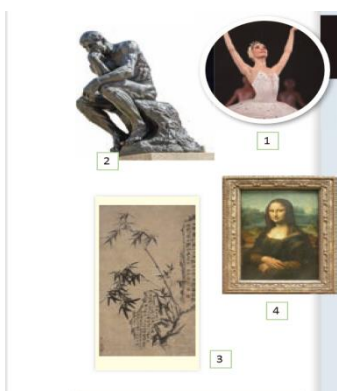
课题: Reading A: People's Artist (Comprehension)

## 1C Unit 2 *Art and Artists*

1. Some of his paintings are flowers, symbolic of prosperity, and vegetables, indicating rich harvests.
2. The dove is another common subject in Qi's art during his later years, showing his wish for world peace.
3. In Chinese culture, the vase symbolises peace and the bat happiness, following the putonghua pronunciations of these words. This painting reveals his hope for a stable and harmonious life, a wish common to people everywhere.
