



- ❑ **fascination** (n.) a very strong attraction, that makes sth very interesting
- ❑ **fascinate** (v.) draw the attention and interest of (sb)

*e.g. Since Eleanor majors in art, I am sure that she will be fascinated by the lifelike wax figures.*

## Step 3: Recommend accommodation

# Sample Essay

- I suggest that Eleanor choose plan C because as an art major, she must be interested in various forms of art.
- Located on the bank of Huangpu River, the Power Station of Art **attracts** thousands of tourists for its various exhibitions. Since Eleanor majors in art, she can **take the opportunity to** appreciate **masterpieces** of many famous artists. She will also **be attracted to** Madame Tussaud's, which allows her to take pictures with the lifelike wax figures. In addition, since it is Eleanor's first visit to Shanghai, the Oriental Pearl Tower **gives her an opportunity to see** the fascinating night view of the city. I am sure she won't be able to **tear her eyes away from** the city **decorated with** colorful lights.
- As for the accommodation, since it is Eleanor's first visit to Shanghai, she will be interested in learning more about this city. Thus, she'd better stay in a guesthouse since the hosts can introduce her to the local culture and customs.
