### 一、教学设计与说明

#### 1. 教学目标

本课为本单元的第5课时,核心目标为学生能描述自己的经历与感受、选择恰当的语言形式进行采访及运用语言和肢体来表达兴趣,并引导学生根据采访内容,为段落书写主题句。

#### 2. 设计思路

首先,教师为学生设定情境,成为校报记者,以任务为导向,让学生完成采访并撰写报道。通过与学生互动探讨得出采访的要素,并借助示例,加深学生的理解,同时引导学生运用语言和肢体表达对某一话题的兴趣,在对话中进行操练。接着,学生4人一组进行采访并演绎,同时借助同伴评价表,引导学生对表演作出评价。完成采访后,教师引导学生将采访内容进行梳理,带领学生逐步得出"主题句",最后让学生练习如何为段落书写主题句。本课作业为学生基于自己小组的采访笔记书写一个段落。

#### 3. 重点及难点

能在口头表达中使用合适的行为和语言来表达对某一话题的兴趣;能基于采访笔记,为段落书写主题句。

# **Lesson Plan**

At the end of the period, students will be able to:

- 1. describe experiences and feelings at the beginning of senior high school life;
- 2. show interest with proper expressions in an interview;
- 3. write a topic sentence for a paragraph based on an interview.

#### **Procedures:**

#### I. Warm-up

- ❖ T: Describe a situation to students where they are all reporters. Have students discuss what an interview involves and brainstorm some interview topics.
- ♦ Ss: Think and share what they can come up with.

Purpose: To arouse students' interest in conducting an interview; to find out students' initial understanding of an interview.

## Guided questions/Instructions:

- 1. What does an interview involve?
- 2. What should the interviewee do during an interview?
- 3. As an interviewer, what should you do to make a good interview?
- 4. Can you brainstorm some interview topics?

### II. Speaking

### **Interactive task 1: prepare for the interview**

- ♦ T: Ask students to read the example in the textbook. Guide students to learn how to raise questions and show interest in an interview.
- ♦ Ss: Read the example and answer the questions.

Purpose: To help students better understand how to conduct an interview.

### Guided questions/Instructions:

- 1. Pay attention to what the interviewer—Li Mei said and see what you can get.
- 2. How can we show interest in an interview?

# **Interactive task 2: application**

- ♦ T: Show an incomplete interview transcript to students and ask students to complete it with proper responses or questions.
- ♦ Ss: Complete the conversation.
- ♦ T: Have some students share their versions and make comments.

Purpose: To help students better understand how to show interest and raise questions.

### Guided questions/Instructions:

1. Here is the interview transcript of my group, but some of my words are missing.

2. Could you guess what responses I gave and what questions I raised?

### **Interactive task 3: act out the interview & peer-review**

- ♦ T: Guide students to understand the directions and clarify the requirements.
- ♦ Ss: Prepare for the interview and act out.
- ♦ T: Ask several groups to perform their interview and have other groups to make assessment according to the peer-review form.
- ♦ Ss: Perform their interview and review other groups' performance.

Purpose: To practice conducting an interview; to learn to assess other students' performance.

### Guided questions/Instructions:

Here are some tips you should follow before conducting an interview:

- Tip 1: decide on the topic of your group
- Tip 2: decide on the roles of group members (1 interviewer, 2 interviewees, 1 note-taker)
- Tip 3: pay attention to how the interviewer starts the conversation, asks questions, shows interest and how the interviewees answer questions
- Tip 4: refer to the peer-review form when you prepare for the interview

#### IV. Writing

### Interactive task 4: write a topic sentence

- ♦ T: Ask students to sort out the ideas of Zhang Yan and Zhao Shan. Guide students to come up with a topic sentence.
- ♦ Ss: Interact with the teacher and write a topic sentence collaboratively.
- → T: Ask students to combine the topic sentence and the selected notes into a paragraph.
- ♦ Ss: Complete the paragraph.
- ♦ T: Summarize and form a checklist for writing.

Purpose: To help students write a topic sentence for a paragraph; to form a checklist for students to check their writing.

Guided questions/Instructions:

- 1. Please sort out the ideas of Zhang Yan and Zhao Shan.
- 2. What were they talking about?
- 3. What was their attitude?
- 4. What should we pay attention to when we write a paragraph?

# **Interactive task 5: application**

- → T: Ask students to look at the sample notes and write a topic sentence by themselves.
- ♦ Ss: Practice writing a topic sentence and share their ideas with the whole class.

Purpose: To train students' skills of writing a topic sentence.

Guided questions/Instructions:

Please write a topic sentence based on the notes.

## VI. Homework:

Write a paragraph for the report based on your interview notes.
