







Speaking Strategy: showing interest with proper expressions

When we are interested in what other people say, we use actions and expressions to participate actively.

Actions: smiling, nodding, ...

Response: Uh-huh. /Oh, I see. / Yeah, that's true. / You are right.

Stronger Response: Really? / Hmm, that's an excellent point! /

Wow! That's amazing! / That's wonderful! / You must be joking!

Grace: Sounds great! I hope you can learn something and enjoy your time there.


Here are some tips you should follow before conducting the interview.

Tip 1: decide on the topic of your group

Tip 2: decide on the roles of group members (1 interviewer, 2 interviewees, 1 note-taker)

Tip 3: pay attention to how the interviewer starts the conversation, asks questions, shows interest and how the interviewees answer questions

Tip 4: refer to the peer-review form when you prepare for the interview
