









“Polysemy”

serious [ˈsɪəriəs] adj.

1. severe in effect; bad 严重的, 糟糕的 e.g., *There were no reports of serious injuries.*

2. not joking or intended to be funny 严肃的, 认真的

e.g., *Please don't laugh — I'm being serious.*

3. determined to follow a particular plan or action 坚决的, 认真的

e.g., *Is she serious about going to live abroad?*

Context Clues




