- Practice rephrasing information so you won't be thrown off by different phrasing.

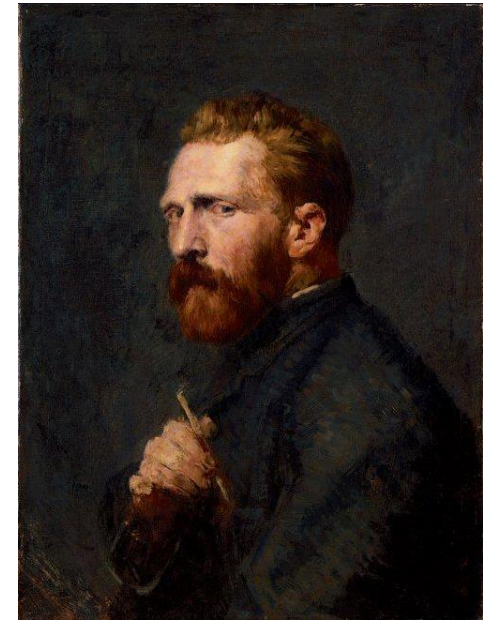


Vincent van Gogh's personal life:

Vincent van Gogh's works:

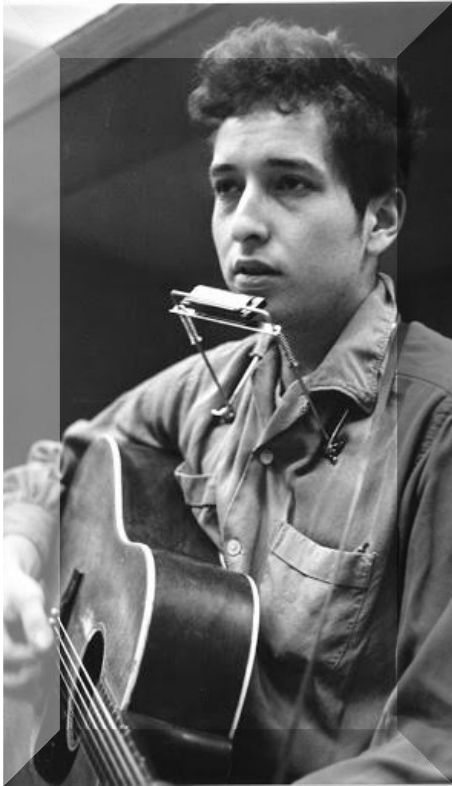
- His works are described as 5 Post-Impressionism.

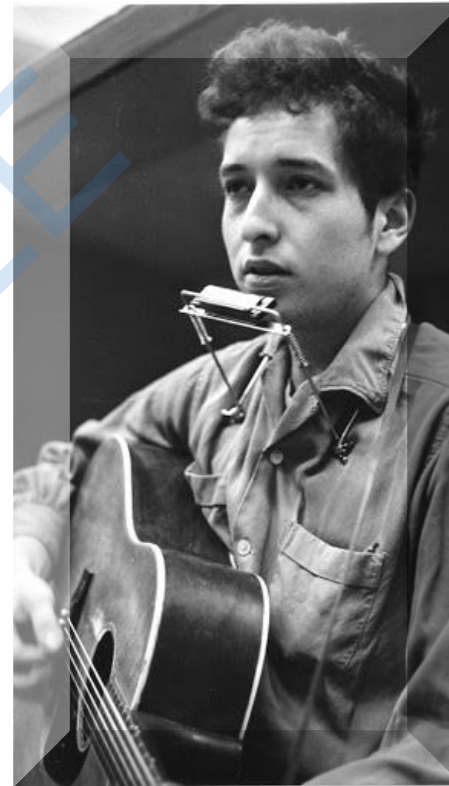

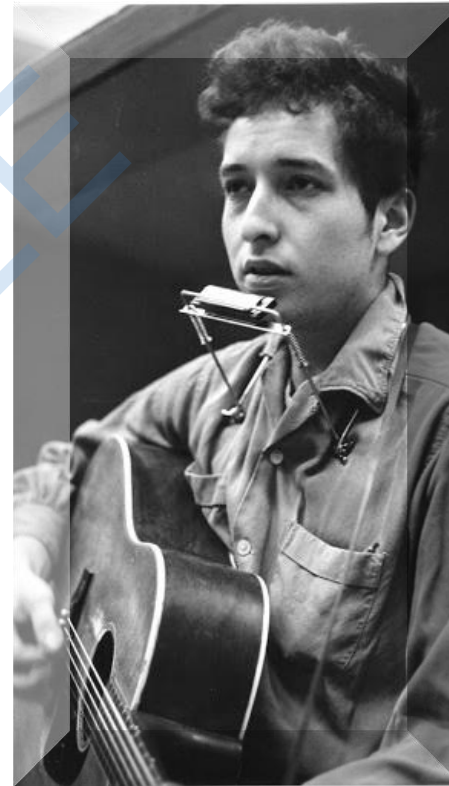

Reference answer:

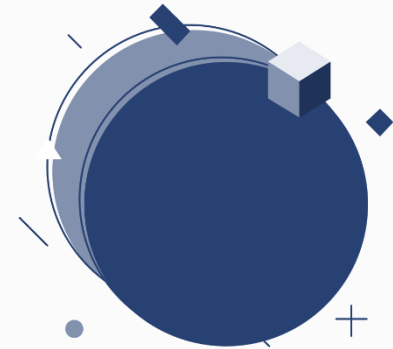
