IV. Brainstorm interview questions in groups of four.

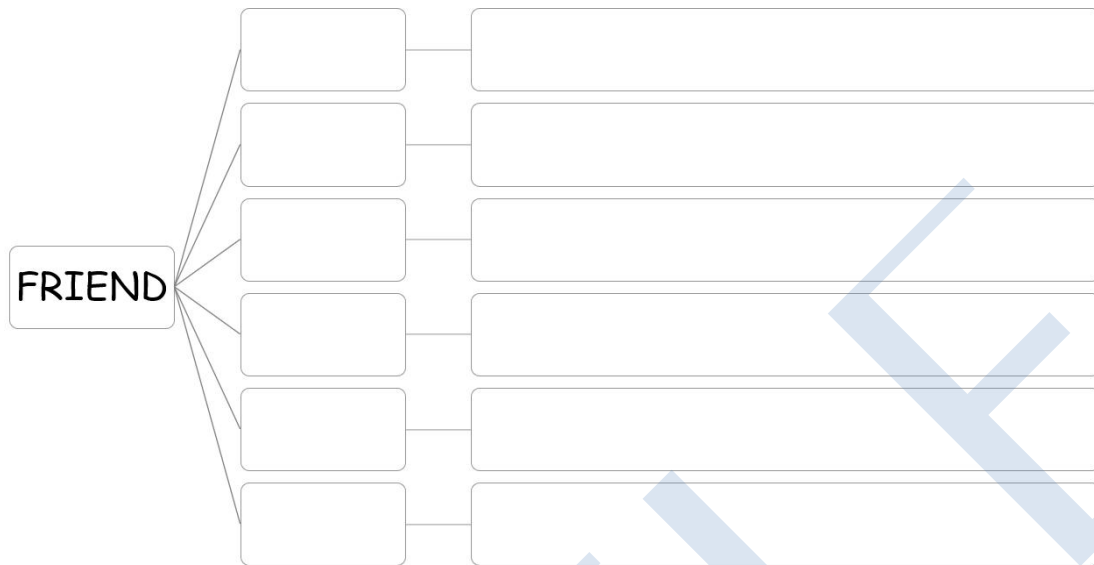
Suppose your group is responsible for collecting teenagers' views on friendship, what questions will you ask in the interview?
